Mrs. Geraldine Hickman**



**January 8, 1953 - April 9, 2005**

It is with great sadness that we inform you of the death of one our teachers, Mrs. Gerri Hickman. Gerri taught at SAS for the past 8 1/2 years in our Middle School Home and Family Life Department. Over the past four years she bravely fought a recurring battle with cancer. In recent weeks her condition weakened and she died in the early morning hours on April 9th at Mt Elizabeth Hospital here in Singapore. Gerri is survived by her husband Joe and her children Joseph and Alexis, both SAS graduates.

With Gerri's passing we lose a little bit of light, a little bit of grace. When visiting with Gerri, we didn't hear about her problems, we heard about her passion for children and how much she cared about them. Her motto was "love them and lead them" and she walked the talk. She was a source of inspiration and we will miss that.

A memorial service for friends and family has been planned for Tuesday, April 12 at 4:30 PM in the Colonial Room at the American Club. We know that you share our concern, support, and sympathy for Gerri's family and her many close friends. She was a talented and highly committed teacher who will be greatly missed at Singapore American School.
